- Trumpet 7 – Contains all the subsequent sequential visions (7 Bowls, 7 Thunders, 3rd Woe, 3rd Great Earthquake)

THE SEVEN THUNDERS

- Revelation 10
- Not recorded for us to know
- These represent the work of the Lion of Judah. Jesus Christ when he returns and the saints are with him.



THE THREE GREAT EARTHQUAKES

- Revelation 6, 11, 16
- Earthquake 1 – Seal 6 – Pseudo-Christian Roman Empire
- Earthquake 2 – Trumpet 6 – French Revolution
- Earthquake 3 – Bowl 6 – Armageddon, Jesus Christ returns and judges the nations



THE THREE WOES

- Revelation 8, 9, 11, 12
- Woe 1 - Trumpets 1-5 - Overthrow of the (Eastern) Roman Empire
- Woe 2 - Trumpet 6 – Overthrow of the (Western) Holy Roman Empire
- Woe 3 - Trumpet 7 – Christ overthrows the political and religious systems of the world



THE DRAGON, THE BEAST, THE FALSE PROPHET

- These three are not always in agreement, but at the time of the end, they will be of one mind to oppose the Lord Jesus Christ.
- The Dragon will be bound for a 1,000 years = Human Leadership, World Empire.
- The Beast and the False Prophet together will be utterly destroyed when Christ returns.
- These three are the antagonist, the great threat against the believers.

Believers become more political due to pressure, persecution, greed, and lack of Biblical understanding.



THE SIXTH SEAL

- A.D. 311-312 to 324
- Began with four emperors, Licinius, Maximin, Maxentius, and Constantine, along with paganism as the state religion
- Ended with Constantine as sole emperor and the Catholic apostasy
- It witnessed an epoch of political triumph for pseudo-Christianity, but of spiritual declension for the Truth as a whole. In an endeavour to make Christianity attractive to pagans, errors which challenged the fundamental teaching of the Apostles were superimposed upon the Truth, whilst practises unseemly to saints were freely indulged in. The previous separation of Christians from any form of political involvement was abandoned by many, who saw no reason why they should not enroll in the legions commanded by Constantine, and so march to war behind the standard of the cross. This attitude and action caused widespread division among followers of Christ. The majority gave their adherence to the errorists, laying the foundation for Catholicism, and exercising a powerful political influence over the Empire.
