



THEN ABISHAI SAID TO DAVID, "GOD HAS GIVEN YOUR ENEMY INTO YOUR HAND THIS DAY. NOW PLEASE LET ME PIN HIM TO THE EARTH WITH ONE STROKE OF THE SPEAR, AND I WILL NOT STRIKE HIM TWICE."
- BUT DAVID SAID TO ABISHAI, "DO NOT DESTROY HIM, FOR WHO CAN PUT OUT HIS HAND AGAINST THE LORD'S ANOINTED AND BE GUILTLESS?" AND DAVID SAID, "AS THE LORD LIVES, THE LORD WILL STRIKE HIM, OR HIS DAY WILL COME TO DIE, OR HE WILL GO DOWN INTO BATTLE AND PERISH. THE LORD FORBID THAT I SHOULD PUT OUT MY HAND AGAINST THE LORD'S ANOINTED. BUT TAKE NOW THE SPEAR THAT IS AT HIS HEAD AND THE JAR OF WATER, AND LET US GO." (26:9-11)



 SO DAVID TOOK THE SPEAR AND THE JAR OF WATER FROM SAUL'S HEAD, AND THEY WENT AWAY. NO MAN SAW IT OR KNEW IT, NOR DID ANY AWAKE, FOR THEY WERE ALL ASLEEP, BECAUSE A DEEP SLEEP FROM THE LORD HAD FALLEN UPON THEM. THEN DAVID WENT OVER TO THE OTHER SIDE AND STOOD FAR OFF ON THE TOP OF THE HILL, WITH A GREAT SPACE BETWEEN THEM. AND DAVID CALLED TO THE ARMY, AND TO ABNER THE SON OF NER, SAYING, "WILL YOU NOT ANSWER, ABNER?" THEN ABNER ANSWERED, "WHO ARE YOU WHO CALLS TO THE KING?" AND DAVID SAID TO ABNER, "ARE YOU NOT A MAN? WHO IS LIKE YOU IN ISRAEL? WHY THEN HAVE YOU NOT KEPT WATCH OVER YOUR LORD THE KING? FOR ONE OF THE PEOPLE CAME IN TO DESTROY THE KING YOUR LORD. THIS THING THAT YOU HAVE DONE IS NOT GOOD.  SAUL RECOGNIZED DAVID'S VOICE AND SAID, "IS THIS YOUR VOICE, MY SON DAVID?" AND DAVID SAID, "IT IS MY VOICE, MY LORD, O KING." AND HE SAID, "WHY DOES MY LORD PURSUE AFTER HIS SERVANT? FOR WHAT HAVE I DONE? WHAT EVIL IS ON MY HANDS? NOW THEREFORE LET MY LORD THE KING HEAR THE WORDS OF HIS SERVANT. IF IT IS THE LORD WHO HAS STIRRED YOU UP AGAINST ME, MAY HE ACCEPT AN OFFERING, BUT IF IT IS MEN, MAY THEY BE CURSED BEFORE THE LORD, FOR THEY HAVE DRIVEN ME OUT THIS DAY THAT I SHOULD HAVE NO SHARE IN THE HERITAGE OF THE LORD, SAYING, 'GO, SERVE OTHER GODS.'  THEN SAUL SAID, "I HAVE SINNED. RETURN, MY SON DAVID, FOR I WILL NO MORE DO YOU HARM, BECAUSE MY LIFE WAS PRECIOUS IN YOUR EYES THIS DAY. BEHOLD, I HAVE ACTED FOOLISHLY, AND HAVE MADE A GREAT MISTAKE." AND DAVID ANSWERED AND SAID, "HERE IS THE SPEAR, O KING! LET ONE OF THE YOUNG MEN COME OVER AND TAKE IT. THE LORD REWARDS EVERY MAN FOR HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS AND HIS FAITHFULNESS, FOR THE LORD GAVE YOU INTO MY HAND TODAY, AND I WOULD NOT PUT OUT MY HAND **AGAINST THE LORD'S ANOINTED.** BEHOLD, AS YOUR LIFE WAS PRECIOUS THIS DAY IN MY SIGHT, SO MAY MY LIFE BE PRECIOUS IN THE SIGHT OF THE LORD, AND MAY HE DELIVER ME OUT OF ALL TRIBULATION." THEN SAUL SAID TO DAVID, "BLESSED BE YOU, MY SON DAVID! YOU WILL DO MANY THINGS AND WILL SUCCEED IN THEM." SO DAVID WENT HIS WAY, AND SAUL RETURNED TO HIS PLACE. 1SAM. 26:21-25



SIXTEEN MONTHS OF SADNESS AND

THEN DAVID SAID IN HIS HEART, "NOW I SHALL PERISH ONE DAY BY THE HAND OF SAUL. THERE IS NOTHING BETTER FOR ME THAN THAT I SHOULD ESCAPE TO THE LAND OF THE PHILISTINES. THEN SAUL WILL DESPAIR OF SEEKING ME ANY LONGER WITHIN THE BORDERS OF ISRAEL, AND I SHALL ESCAPE OUT OF HIS HAND." SO DAVID AROSE AND WENT OVER, HE AND THE SIX HUNDRED MEN WHO WERE WITH HIM, TO ACHISH THE SON OF MAOCH, KING OF GATH. AND DAVID LIVED WITH ACHISH AT GATH, HE AND HIS MEN, EVERY MAN WITH HIS HOUSEHOLD, AND DAVID WITH HIS TWO WIVES, AHINOAM OF JEZREEL, AND ABIGAIL OF CARMEL, NABAL'S WIDOW. AND WHEN IT WAS TOLD SAUL THAT DAVID HAD FLED TO GATH, HE NO LONGER SOUGHT HIM.

• THEN DAVID SAID TO ACHISH, "IF I HAVE FOUND FAVOR IN YOUR EYES, LET A PLACE BE GIVEN ME IN ONE OF THE COUNTRY TOWNS, THAT I MAY DWELL THERE. FOR WHY SHOULD YOUR SERVANT DWELL IN THE ROYAL CITY WITH YOU?" SO THAT DAY ACHISH GAVE HIM ZIKLAG. THEREFORE ZIKLAG HAS BELONGED TO THE KINGS OF JUDAH TO THIS DAY. AND THE NUMBER OF THE DAYS THAT DAVID LIVED IN THE COUNTRY OF THE PHILISTINES WAS A YEAR AND FOUR MONTHS. 1 SAMUEL 27:1-7

THIS CAN'T BE THE HEART OF GOD
NOW DAVID AND HIS MEN WENT UP AND MADE RAIDS AGAINST THE GESHURITES, THE GIRZITES, AND THE AMALEKITES, FOR THESE WERE THE INHABITANTS OF THE LAND FROM OF OLD, AS FAR AS SHUR, TO THE LAND OF EGYPT. AND DAVID WOULD STRIKE THE LAND AND WOULD LEAVE NEITHER MAN NOR WOMAN ALIVE, BUT WOULD TAKE AWAY THE SHEEP, THE OXEN, THE DONKEYS, THE CAMELS, AND THE GARMENTS, AND COME BACK TO ACHISH. WHEN ACHISH ASKED, "WHERE HAVE YOU MADE A RAID TODAY?" DAVID WOULD SAY, "AGAINST THE NEGEB OF JUDAH," OR, "AGAINST THE NEGEB OF THE JERAHMEELITES," OR, "AGAINST THE NEGEB OF THE KENITES." AND DAVID WOULD LEAVE NEITHER MAN NOR WOMAN ALIVE TO BRING NEWS TO GATH, THINKING, "LEST THEY SHOULD TELL ABOUT US AND SAY, 'SO DAVID HAS DONE." SUCH WAS HIS CUSTOM ALL THE WHILE HE LIVED IN THE COUNTRY OF THE PHILISTINES. AND ACHISH TRUSTED DAVID, THINKING, "HE HAS MADE HIMSELF AN UTTER STENCH TO HIS PEOPLE <u>ISRAEL; THEREFORE HE SHALL ALWAYS BE MY SERVANT</u>." 1 SAMUEL 27:8-12

# HOW TO BEHAVE IN A CAVE HERE IS THE MAN WE KNOW....

- NOW WHEN DAVID AND HIS MEN CAME TO ZIKLAG ON THE THIRD DAY, THE AMALEKITES HAD MADE A RAID AGAINST THE NEGEB AND AGAINST ZIKLAG. THEY HAD OVERCOME ZIKLAG AND BURNED IT WITH FIRE AND TAKEN CAPTIVE THE WOMEN AND ALL WHO WERE IN IT, BOTH SMALL AND GREAT. THEY KILLED NO ONE, BUT CARRIED THEM OFF AND WENT THEIR WAY. AND WHEN DAVID AND HIS MEN CAME TO THE CITY, THEY FOUND IT BURNED WITH FIRE, AND THEIR WIVES AND SONS AND DAUGHTERS TAKEN CAPTIVE. THEN DAVID AND THE PEOPLE WHO WERE WITH HIM RAISED THEIR VOICES AND WEPT UNTIL THEY HAD NO MORE STRENGTH TO WEEP. DAVID'S TWO WIVES ALSO HAD BEEN TAKEN CAPTIVE, AHINOAM OF JEZREEL AND ABIGAIL THE WIDOW OF NABAL OF CARMEL.
- AND DAVID WAS GREATLY DISTRESSED, FOR THE PEOPLE SPOKE OF STONING HIM, BECAUSE ALL THE PEOPLE WERE BITTER IN SOUL, EACH FOR HIS SONS AND DAUGHTERS. BUT DAVID STRENGTHENED HIMSELF IN THE LORD HIS GOD. 1 SAMUEL 30:1-6

- THEN DAVID CAME TO THE TWO HUNDRED MEN WHO HAD BEEN TOO EXHAUSTED TO FOLLOW DAVID, AND WHO HAD BEEN LEFT AT THE BROOK BESOR. AND THEY WENT OUT TO MEET DAVID AND TO MEET THE PEOPLE WHO WERE WITH HIM. AND WHEN DAVID CAME NEAR TO THE PEOPLE HE GREETED THEM. THEN ALL THE WICKED AND WORTHLESS FELLOWS AMONG THE MEN WHO HAD GONE WITH DAVID SAID, "BECAUSE THEY DID NOT GO WITH US, WE WILL NOT GIVE THEM ANY OF THE SPOIL THAT WE HAVE RECOVERED, EXCEPT THAT EACH MAN MAY LEAD AWAY HIS WIFE AND CHILDREN, AND DEPART." 1 SAMUEL 30:21-22
- BUT DAVID SAID, "YOU SHALL NOT DO SO, MY BROTHERS, WITH WHAT THE LORD HAS GIVEN US. HE HAS PRESERVED US AND GIVEN INTO OUR HAND THE BAND THAT CAME AGAINST US. WHO WOULD LISTEN TO YOU IN THIS MATTER? FOR AS HIS SHARE IS WHO GOES DOWN INTO THE BATTLE, SO SHALL HIS SHARE BE WHO STAYS BY THE BAGGAGE. THEY SHALL SHARE ALIKE." AND HE MADE IT A STATUTE AND A RULE FOR ISRAEL FROM THAT DAY FORWARD TO THIS DAY. 1 SAMUEL 30:23-25
