

400 Years, issue: basic discipleship

"At any time in our lives...likely we need to <u>return to</u> <u>the LORD</u>..."



"No being a disciple; not being deeply self-reflective is the issue facing all religious people of scripture"

THE PROBLEM Common theme of...Sundays!

"If we were more discerning...would not be sick and weak" 1 Cor 11

Can be deeply religious in practice and failing miserably at application.

The power of Agency: "The capacity to act..."



Learning? Love? Power? Self Discipline?

Work, not magic

Discipline= "...to learn" Discipleship: <u>actively</u> **learning** to be like God.

400 Years, issue: basic discipleship an issue

"<u>If you hold to my teaching</u>, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." Jn. 8:31


Return is...Learning = Work = Action : BETTER?

Success determinants

- "General prefrontal ability; general cognitive ability"
- "...not fixed..."





Success determinants

Re Conscientiousness:

- behaviors represented: goal achievement and self-control, broadly construed.
- Conscientious individuals are clean and tidy, work hard, follow the rules of society and social decorum, think before acting, and are organized. For example, conscientious people tend to write down important dates, comb their hair, polish their shoes, stand up straight, and scrub floors.
- People who are less conscientious exceed their credit limit, watch more television, cancel plans, curse, oversleep, and break promises.

Trait: Conscientiousness

Industriousness*

Orderliness

Point? Intention and effort = Success/BETTER? 50%

"Be ye sober minded..." 3x Pt!

- Constantly muddled
- Aren't sober minded

"Do not bear a grudge."

- Leviticus
- Because we bear grudges

There's a Reason...

We know the struggle: Ever present resistance/weakness

"Many are the afflictions of the righteous..." Ps. 34 "Do not be deceived..." 7X Paul and James.

Because we exist in a state of constant self-deception:

- self-centeredness
- guilt
- fear
- shame
- relentless indulgence
- chronic distraction
- self pity
- self delusion

Point? Return = Learning = Work= Action: BETTER?

Help with inner dialogue.

- Low level level anxiety we are missing out.
- Low level of anxiety we are doing something wrong.

"Fear stifles my ability to think and act wisely"

The wicked flee though no one pursues, but the righteous are as bold as a lion. Pr 28:1

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will fear not. Ps. 46:1

Point? Agency = Return = Learning = Work = Action: **BETTER?**

GOD IS NOT

- We have not a God of fear... 2Tim 1:7
 - Religions of men leverage fear...violence
- God is not a God of Confusion, but of peace: 1Cor 14:33
 - Expectations are clear: Love God by loving your neighbor
 - Proof of his merit: peace/well-being
- God is not a God of the dead, but of the living: Mk 12:27
 - Not about the 'spiritual realm'/ancestors
- God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Gal 6:7
 - God is manifested in changed human character: almost exclusively
- God is NOT A GOD OF MAGIC
 - But of application. Of work. Of industriousness, of intention. Of deliberateness...

-Not a God of Magic...

-Our self discipline matters...

-Our work (industrious) matters...

- Do not pay back evil for evil

-Most anti-superstition message of all time

-Peter is saying new things in spite of them not being new...

<u>Many are the afflictions of the righteous,</u> but the LORD delivers him from them all. He protects all his bones; not one of them will be broken. <u>Evil will slay the wicked, and the</u> <u>haters of the righteous will be condemned</u>. The LORD redeems His servants, and none who <u>take refuge in Him</u> will be condemned. Ps. 34:19-22

-Does he protect? Broken bones?

-God's laws deliver us. BUT NOT WITH MAGIC. We ignore them at our peril

- Haters are condemned:

-We see this in others!



-Reactionary/aggressive/contentious

I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise will always be on my lips. Ps. 34:1

No matter what happens

You are the light of the world.

Let your light <u>so</u> shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

MA. 5: 14 & 16



Your eye is the lamp of your body. When your eyes are good, your whole body also is full of light. But when they are bad, your body is full of darkness. Be careful, then, that the light within you is not darkness. So if your whole body is full of light, with no part of it in darkness, you will be radiant, as though a lamp were shining on you. You are the light of the world.


