Hebrews 3:7-19

"Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "TODAY, IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS AS IN THE REBELLION, IN THE DAY OF TRIAL IN THE WILDERNESS, WHERE YOUR FATHERS TESTED ME, TRIED ME, AND SAW MY WORKS FORTY YEARS. THEREFORE I WAS ANGRY WITH THAT GENERATION, AND SAID, 'THEY ALWAYS GO ASTRAY IN THEIR HEART, AND THEY HAVE NOT KNOWN MY WAYS.' SO I SWORE IN MY WRATH, 'THEY SHALL NOT ENTER MY REST.'

"Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; but exhort one another daily, while it is called "TODAY," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, while it is said: "TODAY, IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS AS IN THE REBELLION." For who, having heard, rebelled? Indeed, was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses? Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

Hebrews 3:7-19

- Heb 3:7 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "TODAY, IF YOU WILL HEAR HIS VOICE,

G2663 Katapausis

Derived From G2664;

G2664 is to settle down, that is, (literally) to colonize, or (figuratively) to (cause to) desist: - cease, (give) rest.

G2663 means reposing down, that is, (by Hebraism) abode: - rest.

This Greek word is only used 9 times in the KJV and all of them except one is used in Hebrews 3&4.

The other one is used in Acts 7:49

" Heaven is my throne, and earth is my footstool: what house will ye build me? saith the Lord or what is the place of my rest? G2663"

G4520 sabbatismos

sab-bat-is-mos'

From a derivative of G4521; a "sabbatism", that is, (figuratively) the *repose* of Christianity (as a type of heaven): - rest.

This definition if we look to where it is derived from we see is of

Hebrew origin [H7676]; the Sabbath (that is, Shabbath), or day of weekly repose from secular avocations (also the observance or institution itself);

- Isaiah 58:13-14 the prophet says to the people that they shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, Nor finding your own pleasure, Nor speaking your own words, Then you shall delight yourself in the Lord;
- Jeremiah 17 19 27. Bear no burden on Sabbath Not entering gates of Jerusalem or carry a burden out of your house nor do any work on Sabbath day

- Mat 4:5 Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple,
