


- INDIFFERENT lacking in empathy 2 Samuel 13:20
- DECEPTIVE doesn't reveal true intentions 2 Samuel 13:20,22,23
- OPPORTUNIST waits for the right time 2 Samuel 13:23
- MANIPULATOR uses others for his ends 2 Samuel 13:27,28
- **DETERMINED** has a persistent focus 2 Samuel 13:24-27
- COWARD runs from the scene 2 Samuel 13:34,37,38

CAIN & ABEL	TWO SONS
2 sons (brothers) strive in a field  Genesis 4:8	2 sons (brothers) strive in a field 2 Samuel 14:6
	One son is slain leaving a <b>single heir</b> 2 Samuel 14:6
Cain fears he will be <b>killed</b> Genesis 4:13	Widow fears heir will be <b>killed</b> 2 Samuel 14:7
Cain laments: he will be driven from 'the face of the earth' Genesis 4:14	Widow fears no name 'upon the face of the earth' (margin) 2 Samuel 14:7
	Widow pleads, her son be <b>delivered</b> from ' <b>revengers</b> ' 2 Samuel 14:11
God judges Cain will <b>not</b> be slain  Genesis 4:15	David judges her son will <b>not</b> die  2 Samuel 14:11

14 But if a man willfully attacks another to kill him by cunning, you shall take him from my altar, that he may die.

Exodus 21:14

#### Woman's two Sons

- 22 But if he thrust him suddenly without enmity, or have cast upon him any thing without laying of wait
- 23 Or with any stone, wherewith a man may die, seeing him not, and cast it upon him, that he die, and was not his enemy, neither sought his harm
- 24 Then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the revenger of blood according to these judgments



## PERFECT IN HIS APPEARANCE

25 But in all Israel there was none to be so much praised as Absalom for his beauty: from the sole of his foot even to the crown of his head there was no blemish in him.

26 And when he polled his head, (for it was at every year's end that he polled it: because the hair was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:) he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.
