## **25 Truly Truly's from John** (Hand out)

Simply put, the phrase means, "I am solemnly telling you the truth." The word "truly" is the Greek word amen: g0281. ? $\mu$ ??  $ame^-n$ ; of Hebrew origin (h543); properly, firm, i.e. (figuratively) trustworthy; adverbially, surely (often as interjection, so be it): — amen, verily. AV (152) - verily 101, amen 51;

- In other words "amen and amen." These saying are of special importance to the audience.
- We would like to see how John presents the Gospel by recording Jesus' Truly, Truly 25 times.

- 5. 5:19 So Jesus said to them, "**Truly, truly**, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise.
- 6. 5:24 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.

- 7. 5:25 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, an hour is coming, and is now here, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live.

- 8. **6: 26** Jesus answered them, "**Truly, truly**, I say to you, you are seeking me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves.
- 9. **6:32** Jesus then said to <u>them</u>, "**Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven, but my Father gives you the true bread from heaven.
- 10. **6:47 Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, whoever believes has eternal life.
- 11. 6:53 So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you.
- 12. 8:34 Jesus answered.... "**Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin.
- 13. 8:51 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death."
- 14. 8:58 Jesus said to them, "**Truly, truly**, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am." a.

15. 10:1"**Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber.

- 16. 10:7 So Jesus again said to them, "**Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, I am the door of the sheep.
- 17. 12:24 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.
- 18. 13:16 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, a servant is not greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him.
- 19. 13:20 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, whoever receives the one I send receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me."

- 20. 13:21 After saying these things, Jesus was troubled in his spirit, and testified, **"Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, one of you will betray me."
- 21. 13:38 Jesus answered, "Will you lay down your life for me? **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, the rooster will not crow till you have denied me three times.
- 22. 14:12 **"Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.
- 23. 16:20 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice. You will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy.

- 24. 16:23 In that day you will ask nothing of me. **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you.
- 25. 21:18 **Truly, truly**, I say to <u>you</u>, when you were young, you used to dress yourself and walk wherever you wanted, but when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and another will dress you and carry you where you do not want to go."
