








MILITARY SERVICE






 - Dan 2:21 He changes times and seasons; he removes kings and sets up kings; he gives wisdom







1. GOD RULES IN THE KINGDOMS OF MEN


- Let's dispense with the obvious...
 - What about the political leaders of Israel and Judah?
 - The kings of Israel and Judah ruled in a theocracy, where God directly governed His people through the kings.
 - This system was unique to Israel and is not meant to serve as a model for modern political systems or a believers involvement in secular governments.
 - What about Joseph and Daniel?
 - Joseph and Daniel had specific, God-ordained roles in political settings, but this was unique to their time. New Testament believers are not called to seek political power.

- There will be a time for us to stand up for our faith
 - "Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world; if my kingdom were of this world, my servants would fight but my kingdom is not from the world (or, my kingdom is from

- kingdom is not from the world (or, my kingdom is from another place)." (John 18:36, NIV)
- Christ also submitted to his fathers (political) will
 - Then Simon Peter, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant and cut off his right ear. (The servant's name was Malchus.) So Jesus said to Peter, "Put your sword into its sheath; shall I not drink the cup that the Father has given me?"(Joh 18:10-11)

 - Heb 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were
 - persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
