






The Return, then Russia Moves

My present conviction therefore, is, that the gathering together of the national armies against Jerusalem is after the appearance of Christ in the South; that is, in Teman; where he begins his career as "THE KING OF THE SOUTH"; and before he appears upon Mount Zion. 
When Does He Come?





Where Does He Take Us?


