



5 basic emotions in babies



- Prefrontal cortex (thinking)
- Limbic system (automatic)
 - amygdala
 - insula
 - hippocampus (memory)
 - hypothalamus (hormones)




Figure 3. https://kids.frontiersin.org/articles/10.3389/frym.2016.00016

Emotions are Meant for Survival

"Emotions are a process, a particular kind of automatic appraisal influenced by our evolutionary and personal past, in which we sense that something important to our welfare is occurring, and a set of psychological changes and emotional behaviors begins to deal with the situation"

"Cognitive studies [...] have observed that our nervous system automatically reorients its processing resources towards two kinds of important stimulation: novel stimuli (i.e., unknown or unexpected) and emotional and motivational stimuli (i.e., important for the individual, such as food, danger, partners, social hierarchy)"

God and Jesus are {perfect} emotional beings


We are made in God's image (Genesis 1) and are {sinful} emotional beings

ANGER Hebrew Words in Psalms

• 639. אף 'aph, af; from 599; properly, the nose or nostril; hence, the face, and occasionally a person; also (from the rapid breathing in passion) ire:—anger(-gry), + before, countenance, face, + forebearing, forehead, + (long-)suffering, nose, nostril, snout, x worthy, wrath.

ANGER

"Therefore, when the LORD heard, he was full of wrath; a fire was kindled against Jacob; his anger rose against Israel [...]

the anger of God rose against them, and he killed the strongest of them and laid low the young men of Israel [...]

Yet he, being compassionate, atoned for their iniquity and did not destroy them; he restrained his anger often and did not stir up all his wrath."

(Psalm 78:21, 31, 38 ESV)

"But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness."

(Psalm 86:15 ESV)

ANGER

Read Psalm 37:1-9


"Refrain from anger, and forsake wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil.

For the evildoers shall be cut off, but those who wait for the LORD shall inherit the land" (v. 9)

FEAR Hebrew Words in Psalms

• 3373. יֵרֵא yare', yaw-ray'; from 3372; fearing; morally, reverent:—afraid, fear (-ful).

• 3372. יֵרֵא yare', yaw-ray'; a primitive root; to fear; morally, to revere; caus. to frighten:—affright, be (make) afraid, dread(-ful), (put in) fear(-ful, -fully, -ing), (be had in) reverence(-end), x see, terrible (act, -ness, thing).



FEAR

"The friendship of the LORD is for those who fear [3373] him, and he makes known to them his covenant."

(Psalm 25:14 ESV)

Read Psalm 23:1-6

"Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear [3372] no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me" (v. 4).

FEAR

"The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear [3372]? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid [6342]?


When evildoers assail me to eat up my flesh, my adversaries and foes, it is they who stumble and fall.

Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear [3372]; though war arise against me, yet I will be confident."

(Psalm 27:1-3 ESV)

DISGUST Hebrew Words in Psalms

• 6962. קוּט quwt, koot; a primitive root; properly, to cut off, i.e. (figuratively) detest:—begrieved, loathe self.



DISGUST

"I look at the faithless with disgust, because they do not keep your commands." (Psalm 119:158 ESV)

"Do I not hate those who hate you, O LORD? And do I not loathe those who rise up against you?

I hate them with complete hatred; I count them my enemies.

Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts!

And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!"

(Psalm 139:21-24 ESV)

DISGUST

"Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous;

for the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish."

(Psalm 1:5-6 ESV)

"My eyes shed streams of tears, because people do not keep your law." (Psalm 119:136 ESV)


SADNESSHebrew Words in Psalms

TEARS:

• 1832. דְמְעָה dimʿah, dim-aw´; feminine of 1831; weeping:—tears.

GRIEF:

• 3708. פַעַס kaʿaç, kah´-as; or (in Job) kaoas, kah´-as; from 3707; vexation:—anger, angry, grief, indignation, provocation, provoking, x sore, sorrow, spite, wrath.



SADNESS

"O LORD, rebuke me not in your anger, nor discipline me in your wrath.

Be gracious to me, O LORD, for I am languishing; heal me, O LORD, for my bones are troubled.

My soul also is greatly troubled. But you, O LORD—how long?

Turn, O LORD, deliver my life; save me for the sake of your steadfast love. For in death there is no remembrance of you; in Sheol who will give you praise?

I am weary with my moaning; every night I flood my bed with tears; I drench my couch with my weeping. My eye wastes away because of grief; it grows weak because of all my foes.

Depart from me, all you workers of evil, for the LORD has heard the sound of my weeping.

The LORD has heard my plea; the LORD accepts my prayer.

All my enemies shall be ashamed and greatly troubled; they shall turn back and be put to shame in a moment." (Psalm 6:1-10 ESV)

SADNESS

"Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation and my God."


(Psalm 42:11 ESV)

"For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning."

(Psalm 30:5 ESV)

Hebrew Words in Psalms

• 7442. רַנַן ranan, raw-nan'; a primitive root; properly, to creak (or emit a stridulous sound), i.e. to shout (usually for joy):—aloud for joy, cry out, be joyful (greatly, make to) rejoice, (cause to) shout (for joy), (cause to) sing (aloud, for joy, out), triumph.



JOY

"Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice.

Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me.

Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit."

(Psalm 51:7-12 ESV)

JOY

"You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

(Psalm 16:11 ESV)

"Your testimonies are my heritage forever, for they are the joy of my heart." (Psalm 119:111 ESV)

Jesus and God's Kingdom Joy Everlasting

The Joy of Salvation

Read Revelation 21:1-4:

"He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away" (v. 4)

Read Isaiah 65:17-19:

"But be glad and rejoice forever in that which I create; for behold, I create Jerusalem to be a joy, and her people to be a gladness" (v. 18)

The Joy of Jesus

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."

(Hebrews 12:1-2 ESV)

The Joy of Jesus

"Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish."

(Ephesians 5:25-27 ESV)
