Eze 38:5 Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them; all of them with shield and helmet:

- A group of nations primarily north of Isreal
- Europe, Russia, Iran, Ethiopia, Libya
- Led by Gog, a nation or king who rules over the Caucasus region

Southern Confederacy

Eze 38:13 Sheba, and Dedan, and the merchants of Tarshish, with all the young lions thereof, shall say unto thee, Art thou come to take a spoil? hast thou gathered thy company to take a prey? to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

- A group of nations aligned with Isreal
- Israel, Arabs, UK, United States, Canada, Australia

Significant Geopolitical Upheaval

Mat 24:29-31 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: 30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. 31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

- The world order is changed dramatically before Christ saves Israel

Time Period Connected to Jerusalem

Mat 24:32-35 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: 33 So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. 34 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled. 35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

- We don't know the day or year
- 70-80 years lifespan
- $1948+80=2028$
- $1967+80=2047$
- The Judgement Seat occurs before the invasion of Israel


Aggravating the North

Dan 11:40-42 And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over. 41 He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon. 42 He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape.

- The nations represented as the Southern King will push and aggravate the Northern King and the nations under their influence
- This pushing will result in significant changes in the world and will bring about their invasion of Israel



Israel in 2026: A New Consensus on Security

First, Israelis' understanding of the nature of the conflict has changed. Today it is clear to the vast majority of Israelis that the root of the conflict is not territorial claim for two states but rather a rejection of the Zionist idea by its enemies. This is largely recognized as true for the leadership of the Palestinian Authority as well as Hamas. More Israelis than ever oppose withdrawing from the West Bank (Judea and Samaria). Such a move, they believe, would not result in peace, but rather would create a Hamas-controlled terror-state in areas adjacent to Israeli population centers.



The Future of Gaza

No political or social transformation will survive without economic revival. Gaza's economy must be rebuilt around a reconstruction authority insulated from corruption, with major Arab and international financing, in partnerships with Israeli private-sector actors, in a long-term vision that integrates Gaza with the global economy, with energy, water, and transportation infrastructure, a modern port and logistics systems, industrial zones and vocational training for tens of thousands of young people. The old economic dependency breeder radicalism while the new economic dignity should breed self-confidence and stability.

The Middle East at a Moment of Strategic Choice

The Abraham Accords represent a deliberate shift away from ideological conflict toward pragmatic cooperation, from permanent grievance and proxy warfare toward regional integration and sovereign responsibility. The Accords are the product of sustained strategic effort, intellectual clarity, and unusual political courage.





Defining an Acceptable Outcome to the Russo-Ukraine War

As of mid-December 2025, European institutions, nearly four years after the Russian invasion of Ukraine, cannot agree on the disposition of Russian state assets temporarily frozen in European banks. Despite the imposition of sanctions, Europeans continue to import a variety of raw materials from Russia, from natural gas to uranium, and the value of Western-Russian trade roughly equals the aid provided to Ukraine.

President Donald Trump has brought unprecedented scepticism about Europe's contribution to NATO to the White House. His administration's disdain for European "free loading," alongside its shifting of priorities towards countering China, has the European Allies bracing for likely troop withdrawals.

Can Europe Trust the United States Again?


In Donald Trump's second term in office, the transatlantic relationship that helped define the postwar European project and global order appears broken. Is it time for Brussels to chart its own path?



What the New US National Security Strategy Really Signals for Europe

The United States has released its new National Security Strategy (NSS), and for Europe—especially its frontline states—it marks more than a periodic policy update. It signals the emergence of a distinct US strategic doctrine: one that reorders global priorities, reframes Allies' roles, and seeks stability in Europe chiefly so that Washington can redirect its focus to the Indo-Pacific and the Western Hemisphere. The document will be read in Washington as pragmatic. In Europe, it lands as a strategic inflexion point.

2026: Europe's year of bad choices

The United States is reshaping the international order in ways Russia has long dreamed of. Washington's recent military operation in Venezuela leaves little doubt that in today's world, it is force—not law—that prevails. Europe, including Estonia (as part of European decisions), is facing a year of difficult choices that will test its ability to shape its own destiny. The most difficult choices will come not from the east but from the west.
