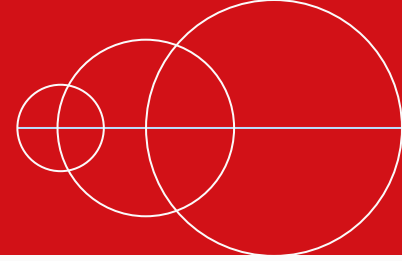

# *Galatians so far...*



- **Justification by Faith:** Righteousness is attained through faith in Jesus Christ, not by adhering to the Jewish Law.
- **Freedom in Christ :** Believers are freed from the bondage of the Law,
- **The Gospel vs. Legalism:** Paul defends the "true gospel" against "Judaizers" who demanded circumcision, emphasizing that adding works to grace invalidates the sacrifice of Christ.
- **The Role of the Spirit:** Rather than following legalistic rules, believers are called to walk in the Spirit, which produces good fruit and enables loving service.
- **Equality in Christ:** Barriers based on ethnicity, social status, or gender are abolished regarding salvation, as all are united as one in Christ.
- **The Promise to Abraham:** The gospel fulfills the ancient promise to Abraham, extending God's blessing to both Gentiles and Jews through faith.

**Romans 6:6:** "We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin."

**John 8:34:** "Jesus answered them, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin.'"

**1 Cor 15:54-57:** "When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: 'Death is swallowed up in victory.' 'O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?' The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."
